

Study Day - Students in Exile: Issues and Inclusive Dynamics

Since 2019, the Mens network (Migrants in Higher Education) and the ADCUEFE (Association des Directeurs des Centres Universitaires d'Études Françaises pour Étrangers) have been promoting the accreditation of a new university diploma: the DU Passerelle. This scheme gives students from exile countries access to this training in French as a foreign language and provides them with support in the various steps they need to take to integrate into university life and their daily,

The LIDILE (Linguistics - Engineering - Didactics of Languages) laboratory is structured around a didactic axis, the DILEM (Didactics of Languages and Multimedia), whose activities focus, among other things, on issues of inclusion through language and in the language classroom.

LIDILE is organising a multi-disciplinary day bringing together teacher-researchers, professionals and students to discuss the question of the inclusive processes put in place for and by students in exile. The study day is preceded by a themed evening at the Arvor cinema, where a writing workshop will be held, followed by a screening of the film Même si tu vas sur la lune and a discussion with the film crew.

These events are open to all, free of charge, with the exception of the film screening at the Arvor cinema.
